Heart-related contacts, medications, devices, and emergency handoff notes

Use this printable to write down emergency information before it is needed.

Keep the current copy with a caregiver binder, refrigerator packet, go-bag, discharge folder, or other trusted handoff location.

Care team and contacts

☐ Cardiology office and after-hours contact

☐ Primary care clinician and pharmacy

☐ Preferred hospital or usual facility

☐ Emergency contact and caregiver contact

Heart-related information to organize

☐ Heart conditions or concerns to share from the chart or care plan

☐ Medication list and prescribing clinicians

☐ Allergies and medication reactions

☐ Blood thinner name, if applicable

☐ Pacemaker / ICD card location, if applicable

Documents and handoff notes

☐ Device card, implant ID, or cardiology paperwork location

☐ Recent hospital or clinic paperwork location

☐ Communication, mobility, or caregiver notes

☐ Questions to bring back to the cardiology or primary care team
